Call for Posters 2015 ACA Conference June 11-13, 2015 Hotel Saskatchewan, Regina

The ACA 2015 Program Team is pleased to invite submissions for posters that will be presented in an exciting new format at this spring's annual conference "Perspectives on the Archival Horizon".

Posters are an excellent opportunity to highlight your repository, a digitization or outreach project, research results, or other initiative, and to share your work with colleagues from across the country. Posters summarize an initiative or project using text and images, with the presenter available in-person for questions. This year poster creators can promote their poster at a special Poster Plenary session. This fast-paced, exciting session provides greater exposure to the poster displays.

The poster should be 48" wide (121 cm), and up to 48" high (121 cm). ACA provides the stands for display of the posters and, if requested can arrange a power supply for any digital enhancements to the poster; however the ACA cannot guarantee the reliability of internet access in the display area. Successful applicants will receive additional detailed information about the display units and poster production recommendations, including paper type.

Poster presenters are invited to deliver a 3-5 minute "lightning" talk to encourage conference delegates to see their poster. Posters will then be on display the rest of the day, Friday June 12. Presenters should be available at their poster at least for the plenary poster session and the afternoon refreshment break.

Please submit your poster proposal online at http://archivists.ca/content/aca-conference-poster-submission by **Monday, January 12, 2015.** Up to 12 poster presentations will be selected by the Program Team for display. The ACA reserves the right to cancel the poster session in the event that insufficient submissions are received.
